2. Equipment: Patrol method camping, so bring your tents and your ten-essential camping items.

Make sure you have your headlamp with you or in the very top of your pack so you can quickly and easily get it. Camp needs to be set up quickly upon arrival.

3. Class A uniform is required for opening and closing ceremony.

This is spring camping, so plan your clothing to be “layered” so you can adjust for the different temperatures during the day. Remember... THIS IS GERMANY!!

Include foul/wet weather clothing; boots, hat and gloves

4. Comments: Troops, Crews and Dens are invited to run one of the events. Check-in will be Friday evening, Saturday will be chock full of events, and check out will be on Sunday, so be prepared for a full weekend of camping and FUN!
