Location: Garmisch, Germany (Marshall Center)

Dates: 20-21 March 2010

Cost: \$40 for the weekend, \$25 per day (includes lunch, breaks, and event patch)

Registration: 0830-0900 Daily

Opening Ceremony: 0900-0920 Daily

Lodging: Responsibility of the Scouter to organize, there are many locations available in the area to include Edelweiss Lodge and Resort.

Child Care: A Child's Day out Program will be offered through TAC. Space is limited to 20 children (Must be Potty Trained).

Cost for both days: \$20.00 includes lunch, snack, and all activities.
