

## **Peacelight Guidelines and Procedures**

1. The Peacelight of Bethlehem flame will be distributed at a special ceremony in Vienna on Saturday December 12, 2009. If your Boy Scout troop would like to represent TAC at this ceremony, please contact Marilee Bisoni right away. Local host country Scout groups will take the flame by train to central distribution points throughout Europe.
2. Collect the Peacelight flame from the central distribution point nearest you (a railway station, or even a local host country Scout group, a local church for example) on Saturday December 12<sup>th</sup> (for Italy) or Sunday December 13<sup>th</sup> (rest of Europe). Marilee Bisoni will inform all packs and troops that are registered with her for the Peacelight activity the exact time and place for flame distribution.
3. Take the flame back to a "Special Pack or Troop Peacelight Meeting" for all the Scouts. The Scouts will bring the lantern they have made or purchased to the meeting.
4. At the meeting give a short presentation about the Peacelight and its meaning, then distribute the flame to the Scouts.
5. Each Scout will then take the flame home and keep the light burning at least until December 27<sup>th</sup> or, if possible, Epiphany.
6. Each Scout should take the flame to 3 neighborhood families.
7. Each Pack and Troop should distribute the flame to 1 church and 1 school in the neighborhood with an appropriate ceremony so that as many people as possible can receive the Peacelight of Bethlehem.
